Distribution Ready Packaging

- Packaging that minimizes resistance through our distribution centers
 - Accuracy of
 - pack lists
 - master carton labeling
 - unit carton labeling
 - packaging specification
 - Remailer packaging
- Packaging which can withstand the small parcels distribution environment
 - Passing packaging test reports
 - Passing inbound packaging testing
 - Adequate internal packaging components


Right Size Packaging

- Finding the optimal balance between overpackaging and underpackaging
 - Maximizes cube efficiency
 - Too little cube may result in product ship damage
 - Too much cube results in added transportation and storage costs.
 - Provide adequate internal packaging
 - Underpackaged – product will incur damage which may result in expensive chargebacks
 - Overpackaged – results in wasted cube and added material costs




Material Requirements

- Lightweight items **60 pounds and under** – it is best to use individual shipping cartons with a **minimum 200 pounds** per square inch corrugate burst strength
- Heavyweight items **over 60 pounds** – It is best to use individual shipping cartons with a **minimum 275 pounds** per square inch corrugate burst strength.
- A single unit carton with Outer AND Inner protective packaging able to withstand the distribution, storage, handling, and shipment through the small parcel distribution environment (FedEx, UPS, USPS, etc.) without any additional packaging or preparation supplied by Colony Brands to ship to Retailer’s customer.



Ship Alone Size Requirements

- Packaged items greater than 26" in length, **OR** 15" in width, **OR** greater than 1.50 cubic feet must be sent to the warehouse in single unit Remainers.
 - These items will be sent directly to the Retailer's customer. Colony Brands will provide no additional packaging.



OR

$$15'' \times 26'' \times 7'' = \frac{2730}{1728} = 1.58 > 1.50$$

The above are examples that meet Ship Alone criteria and must be sent in a Remailer



Master Carton Requirements

- All packaged items that are less than Ship Alone size should be shipped to the distribution centers in master cartons (cartons containing two or more single selling units)
- May be marked using recognizable international symbols that pertain to the item such as Fragile, Glass, This Side Up, Etc.



When packing into a master carton, you must follow these steps:

Each Master Carton must:

- Contain only one purchase order and shipping destination.
- Contain only one Package Label Number (PLN).
- Contain only one Color or Pattern or Size.
 - Limit mixed multiple colors, patterns or sizes in a master carton to 1 (one) carton per shipment.
 - Label this master carton with “MIXED MASTER”.
- All master cartons for the same PLN in the same shipment need to have a constant piece count per carton.
 - Limit short quantity master cartons to 1 (one) carton per shipment.
 - Label this master carton with “SHORT QUANTITY”.

Master Cartons should meet minimum and maximum requirements, as shown below.

	Longest	Middle	Smallest	Weight
Minimum	9"	9"	4"	5 lbs.
Maximum	36"	30"	26"	50 lbs.

Accessororial Charges

To minimize postage impacts and accessororial charges by our carriers, we ask that you:

- Work to develop packaging that best fits the size of the item, minimizes dead space, and over packaging without ruining the integrity of the package to provide protection against damage in a small parcel shipping environment.
- **Heavyweight Charge** – Any package over 70 pounds (\$8 per unit)
- **Large Package Charge** – Any package with a girth (length + 2W + 2H) greater than 130 inches (\$45 per unit)
- **Additional Handling Charge** – Any package with longest side exceeding 48 inches or its second-longest side exceeding 30 inches (\$8 per unit)
- All shipping cartons must be sealed to prevent tampering or loss of product.

- Barcode specifications
 - Format – Code 128 (subset A, B, or C)
 - Minimum size 1.5 Wide" x 1" High
 - Whitespace – 1/8" on right and left sides
- Label Specifications
 - Font and Size – 12-point Arial Black
 - Min size – 2" x 2"
 - Max Size – 3" x 3"
 - Human Readable text of PLN
- Placement
 - Largest Flat Surface



Packaging List Requirements

- Supplier name/address
- Colony Brands purchase order number
- Colony Brands package label number (PLN)
 - If multiple PLN's separate each by line item and include quantity units and quantity of cases
 - Each line must include the Colony Brands item description including style, color, and size information (this information may be abbreviated).
- Date shipped
- Total quantity of units
- Total number of cartons for purchase order
- Insert packing lists into a removable pouch and securely attach it to one carton of each purchase order. Indicate "PACKING LIST ATTACHED" on two adjacent sides of the carton. For trailer load shipments, the pouch must be attached to the last carton loaded on the trailer.
- When shipping a small quantity cartons via UPS or FedEx, a copy of the packing slip must be attached to each carton




Master Carton Labeling

Label must include the following:

- Purchase Order Number
- Package Label Number
- Item Description
- Case Quantity
- Master Carton Sequence

- Barcode specifications
 - Format – Code 128 (subset A, B, or C)
 - Size – Minimum 2.5" x 2"
- Label Specifications
 - Size – Minimum 3" x 4"
 - Labels may be larger, above is recommended
- Placement
 - Upper right corner of the carton
 - May be printed directly on the Master Carton, if so, can be printed anywhere on the carton (only one side required)
 - Must add white barcode meeting the minimum size requirements of 2.5" x 2"



Label Approvals

- Each supplier/factory must submit unit carton package labels for approval at least **10 days** prior to shipment of your first order or use our designated preferred label provider, StreamLine Labels (Asia & USA).
- Labels must be submitted to the labeling department **by email to** NonFoodPkgLabels@ColonyBrands.com
 - 1 printed master carton sample required
 - 1 printed unit label sample required
- Once reviewed, approvals or corrections will be provided via email.

Packaging Specification Requests on Setup Form

- All dimensions and weights are to be filled using the Imperial System (Inches/Pounds)
- Once you have received a Setup Form from sourcing, the PKG tab of the Excel document must be completed.
- Fields to complete are:
 - Single selling unit packaging
 - Dims and weight
 - Remailer included
 - If available, what is added cost?
 - Inner packaging protection

- Box A B Fields:** Fields will need to be completed when, Scenario A: Product must be shipped in multiple boxes due to size, weight, shape, etc. Scenario B: Pack Number has different styles under the child parts that have different packaging dims. Example - Pack # has a sitting figure (8" x 10" x 6") and a standing figure (10" x 3" x 3"). Box A B Fields must be completed.



Additionally, charges related to sending replacements to customers as a result of receipt of damaged items.
