Important Safeguards

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USING AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS!

- FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY. DO NOT USE THIS APPLIANCE FOR OTHER THAN ITS INTENDED USE.
- To interrupt coffee brewing at any time, press the power button.
- REMOVE all packaging materials and labels before first use.
- Wash all removable parts before first use. See Cleaning & Care.
- A short cord is provided to reduce the hazards resulting from entanglement or tripping. If this is a detachable cord, always attach it to the appliance first, then to the electrical outlet. DO NOT drape the cord over a counter or tabletop, where it can be pulled on or tripped over. Never wrap the cord tightly around the appliance, as this could cause the cord to fray or break. DO NOT cover the cord with a rug.
- We DO NOT recommend using an extension cord with this appliance. However, if an extension cord is used, the marked electrical rating should be at least as great as the electrical rating of this appliance.
- CLOSE SUPERVISION IS NECESSARY WHEN USING THIS APPLIANCE NEAR CHILDREN.
- A fire may occur if this appliance is used near flammable materials, including curtains, towels, walls, etc. DO NOT place any paper, plastic or other nonfood items in the appliance. DO NOT place the appliance or its cord on or near a heated surface or in a heated oven.
- This appliance should always be used on a stable, dry, heat-resistant surface.
- DO NOT use near water. DO NOT operate with wet hands.
- DO NOT operate this appliance with an external timer or remote control.
- DO NOT use an accessory or attachment not recommended by the manufacture, as this may cause injury or damage the appliance.
- DO NOT attempt to move an appliance when it is hot or has hot contents.
- DO NOT use outdoors.
- Turn off and unplug this appliance when not in use.
- THERE ARE NO SERVICEABLE PARTS INSIDE THIS APPLIANCE.
- DO NOT USE AN APPLIANCE WITH A DAMAGED CORD OR PLUG, OR AFTER THE APPLIANCE MALFUNCTIONS OR HAS BEEN DAMAGED IN ANY MANNER.
- Always use cold water (purified water) in your coffee maker. Warm water or other liquids, unless listed in the cleaning section, may cause damage to the coffee maker. Do not put the glass in the microwave.
- Do not place an empty cup on the warming plate while the coffee maker is on, as the cup may break or be damaged.

Electrical Safety

This appliance is equipped with a polarized plug in which one prong is wider than the other. This is a safety feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. The plug should be attached to the appliance before connecting to an electrical outlet. The plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If you are unable to insert the plug into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way. The manufacturer cannot accept any liability for damage or injury resulting from failure to observe these safety procedures.
