### READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USING AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS!

- FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY. DO NOT USE THIS APPLIANCE FOR OTHER THAN ITS INTENDED USE.
- Remove all packaging materials and labels before first use.
- Wash all removable parts before first use. See Cleaning & Care.
- A short cord is provided to reduce the hazards resulting from entanglement or tripping. If this is a detachable cord, always attach it to the appliance first, then to the electrical outlet. DO NOT drape the cord over a counter or tabletop, where it can be pulled on or tripped over. DO NOT wrap the cord tightly around the appliance, as this could cause the cord to fray or break. DO NOT cover the cord with a rug.
- We DO NOT recommend using an extension cord with this appliance. However, if an extension cord is used, the marked electrical rating should be at least as great as the electrical rating of this appliance.
- CLOSE SUPERVISION IS NECESSARY WHEN USING THIS APPLIANCE NEAR CHILDREN.
- A fire may occur if this appliance is used near flammable materials, including curtains, towels, walls, etc. DO NOT place any paper, plastic, or other non-food items in the appliance. DO NOT place the appliance or its cord on or near a heated surface, or in a heated oven.
- Place this appliance on a stable, dry, heat-resistant surface.
- DO NOT use near water.
- DO NOT use an accessory or attachment not recommended by Wards, as this may cause injury, or damage the appliance.
- Keep hands, hair and clothing away from all moving parts.
- Always use oven mitts when handling hot food or appliances. DO NOT attempt to move an appliance when it is hot or has hot contents.
- DO NOT use outdoors.
- Turn off and unplug this appliance when not in use.

This appliance is equipped with a polarized plug in which 1 prong is wider than the other. This is a safety feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. If you are unable to insert the plug into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way. Montgomery Ward can not accept any liability for damage or injury resulting from failure to observe these safety procedures.

This appliance is equipped with a detachable magnetic, polarized plug. These are safety features to reduce the risk of electrical shock. The magnetic plug should be attached to the appliance before connecting to an electrical outlet. This plug is designed to attach to the appliance only 1 way. Check the plug for the printing "this side up" before attaching to the appliance. The polarized plug will fit into a polarized outlet only 1 way. If you are unable to insert the plug into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way. Montgomery Ward cannot accept any liability for damage or injury resulting from failure to observe these safety procedures.

This appliance is equipped with a 3-prong grounding plug. This is a safety feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. Using an extension cord is not recommended with this appliance. The plug should be attached to the appliance before connecting to an electrical outlet. It is recommended that an electrical outlet serving ONLY this appliance be used. This outlet must be properly installed and grounded. If you have any questions about the grounding or electrical instructions, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way. Montgomery Ward cannot accept any liability for damage or injury resulting from failure to observe these safety procedures.

1. Turn off and unplug the appliance.
